Principal's Message

Dearest Parents:

May you and your family be safe and happy! As the new school year begins, your children are gradually adapting to the rhythm of school life. With grateful hearts, we would like to share some recent good news and key teaching points for each grade level, and sincerely invite you to join us in accompanying your child on a fulfilling and heartwarming journey of growth.



With immense gratitude, we previously announced to you: Our school's application to increase the capacity of Whole Day Classes has been officially approved by the Education Bureau! This expansion is significant, meaning our school will expand from offering Whole Day Classes only to K2 and K3 (a total of 31 places) to offering Whole Day and morning classes in all three grades: K1, K2 and K3. The total number of Whole Day places has increased substantially to 82. This achievement is an important step in responding to community needs and committing to providing children with a more stable and consistent learning environment. We thank all parents again for their support and cooperation, and we look forward to continuing to work together to create a richer environment for children's growth.

This academic year we will focus on "Explore nature, cultivate character" at its core, we are committed to integrating two key focuses—"strengthening learning through nature and life experiences" and "deepening Chinese culture curriculum"—into daily teaching. We hope to inspire children's curiosity and proactive learning spirit through engaging, life-oriented exploration activities; simultaneously, through Chinese cultural immersion, we aim to subtly cultivate their character and positive values. Building on this foundation, each level of instruction will focus on progressive developmental goals: preschool children will begin with a sense of security, enjoying school, learning to share, and developing self-reliance; lower kindergarten children will become active explorers, actively observing, confidently expressing themselves, and practicing friendship and mutual assistance; upper kindergarten children will move towards self-discipline and autonomy, learning to take on responsibilities such as checking homework and packing their school bags, and expressing their thoughts in an organized manner, laying a solid foundation for their future learning careers.

We firmly believe that education is "Home", "School" and "Children" a journey of shared growth. In the coming months, we will be conducting a series of engaging educational activities centered around the above key points. We cordially invite you to join us on this journey, sharing stories of school and home with your children, offering them encouragement and praise. May the Lord bless your family with joy and peace!

Through the theme of "School," young children learn about the people, facilities, and school supplies in school, as well as the daily routines and rules of school life. Through various activities, children explore the school environment and facilities, learn to identify their personal belongings, and express their needs in simple language.





Through the theme of “Knowing Yourself,” children learn the names and functions of different parts of their bodies. Through the picture book “The Little Monkey Grows Up,” which depicts a little monkey picking pears, children learn to face difficulties with perseverance and a proactive approach to problem-solving.



Through the theme of “Family,” children learn the names and characteristics of family members, learn to admit their mistakes and express their emotions simply, and cultivate an attitude of gratitude and care for their family members.



Through the theme of "school," we teach and nurture young children to enjoy a pleasant group life at school. We aim to cultivate their initiative and friendliness in making friends, learning to get along well with friends, getting to know the people in school, and understanding the school environment. We also thank our Heavenly Father for giving us the love to pray for others.





Through the theme of “Knowing Yourself,” children are guided to learn the names and functions of different parts of their bodies. Through multi-sensory exploration, children learn that everyone’s appearance and strengths are different, and they can accept and appreciate themselves from different perspectives, discover their talents, appreciate what they have done, and thus build a healthy self-image.



Through the theme of “seasons,” children learn about the temperature changes, characteristics, and clothing of the four seasons through different exploration activities. They learn to dress appropriately for different seasons, observe and appreciate the natural environment, and cultivate their curiosity for exploration.

Through the theme “People Who Help Us,” young children explore who else in their community helps them, beyond their family. In addition to recognizing those who help them, children learn to respect and thank them, and also to give thanks to God for the people who help them.





Through the theme of “Healthy Living,” children will develop healthy lifestyle habits through three aspects: a balanced diet, regular exercise, and a structured daily routine. In addition to recognizing the importance of these three aspects for health, children will also examine their own lifestyle habits and express gratitude to God for creating day and night.



Through the theme “The World Is Different,” children learn about the cultural differences between different countries, recognize the food, flags, traditional clothing, and famous landmarks of different countries, and learn to respect people of different nationalities. They also learn to abide by the relevant rules and regulations when visiting places abroad, enhancing their self-discipline and cultivating civic virtue.


